1. **Call to Order:** By Chairman Teitgen at 6:30 p.m. – 4 others in attendance.
2. **Roll Call:** F. Teitgen, R. Schmidt, V. Auck, D. Long(excused absence), S. Smith, R. Lombardo, K. Schulenburg, & M. Schmidt.
3. **Approval of Agenda.** Approved with moving of item #9 to #7.
4. **Rules of Conduct.** Be courteous and civil.
5. **Approval of last meeting minutes.** Approved as presented.
6. **Constable's Report.** Street signs continue to disappear, garbage behind rental units at the former Beck's on the Water location.
7. **Appearance by J. Stauffer of Lakeside Bar regarding summer outdoor entertainment band schedule.** Committee pleased with the schedule.
8. **Appearance by G. Trotter regarding "jake braking" on Tipperary Rd.** Item tabled pending appearance by Mr. Trotter. (Note: Mr. Trotter appeared before TB who agreed to add No Jake Braking signs to Tipperary Rd.)
9. **Appearance by L. Cornellier regarding fireworks sales permits.** No action taken at this time, Teitgen to follow up with Town's Attorney and report back to the Committee.
10. **Continued Discussion of Municipal Court.** Clerk to continue attempts to contact City of Portage Clerks for Information regarding the use of the Municipal Courts.
11. **Possible ordinance for use of clear bags at the recycle site.** Teitgen/Smith motion to recommend Town Board approval of the ordinance, MC. Added penalty reference to Ordinance, noted need to check with Town Attorney as to why the General Penalty and Deposit Schedules do not match up with Ordinances.
12. **Revisions to the existing Waste Management Plan.** R. Schmidt working on the updated version, will forward revised draft to Clerk & Safety Committee.
13. **Continuation of discussion regarding Wind Turbines.** Item tabled, pending return of Dan Long. Chairman passed out article from Bayfield Co-op Magazine which noted 600 turbines and 125 acres would be required to provide power equivalent to the Columbia coal fired power plant, and would still not have back-up for when the wind is not blowing.
14. **Continuation of discussion of request for speed bumps on portion of Tipperary Rd.** No action taken, suggests use of "please slow down" signs and the speed board. Speed humps would need to be permanent type, placed every 300' which would be very expensive.
15. **Continuation of discussion regarding Snowmobile Ordinance.** Lombardo/Schulenburg motion to recommend Town Board approval, MC.
16. **Future agenda items. (no discussion permitted.)** Wind Energy Systems, Waste Management Plan, Municipal Courts, Fee/Deposit Schedule.
