3. **Approval of Agenda.** Approved as presented.
4. **Rules of Conduct.** Dispensed with, no others in attendance.
5. **Approval of 2-7-2013 minutes.** Approved as presented.
6. **Constable's Report.** Hybrid wolf/dog complaint on Phillips Rd., boat landings are now all open, placed some temporary "no parking" signs due to muddy conditions and parking issues, ongoing parking issue on Parkway Dr., will look into possibly raising the park reservation fee, Teitgen/Smith motion to approve checking into a microchip scanner for use with stray/lost/found dogs, MC.
7. **Possible reduction of Speed Limit on Kent Road 2 - update.** Teitgen/McEvelly motion to recommend Town Board approval of reducing the speed limit from 55 mph to 45 mph on the section of Kent Rd. between McMillan and CTH J, MC.
8. **Possible reduction of Speed Limit on Kent Rd. 1, update/possible recommendation to TB.** Still a work in progress, SC does recommend TB approval to reduce the speed limit to 35 mph once paperwork has been approved by the DOT.
9. **Amendments to Section 1.02 of the Town Code of Ordinances, Authorization for Use of Citations, including Schedule of Deposits.** Smith/Schulenburg motion to recommend TB approval, MC.
10. **Amendments to Sections 1.03 of the Town Code of Ordinances, General Penalty.** Teitgen/Smith motion to recommend TB approval, MC.
11. **Discussion and possible action on reference to and consistent language for Violations and Penalties in Town ordinances.** Teitgen/Smith motion to approve, MC.
12. **Possible draft website language regarding discharging of firearms in densely populated areas of the Town.** Discussion only McEvelly will look into other municipalities for a sample ordinance/language, would like to see no shooting allowed in areas that have a 25 – 35 mph speed zone.
13. **Review/Possible approval of Outdoor Entertainment Application form.** Schmidt/Teitgen motion to recommend TB approval with the fee changed to \$25, MC.
14. **Future agenda items. (no discussion permitted).** Possible fee schedule update/amendment, follow up on Kent Rd. speed limits, and discharging of fire arms in densely populated areas.
