1. **Call to Order:** By Chairman Teitgen at 6:30 p.m.
2. **Roll Call:** F. Teitgen, R. Schmidt(absent), V. Auck, S. Smith, K. Schulenburg, T. Leckwee, L. Clark, M. Schmidt.
3. **Approval of Agenda.** Approved as presented.
4. **Rules of Conduct.** Normal rules apply.
5. **Approval of 3-4-2014 minutes.** Approved as presented.
6. **Constable's Report.** None.
7. **Brief public Comments.** R. Ament commended the Safety Committee and Town Board on all the work put into the Tourist Rooming House ordinance.
8. **Discussion/possible action regarding storage of piers on boat lifts under ordinance provision 9.02(d)(7) as it relates to distance off of pavement for such storage.** Schulenburg/Clark motion to put at least a 3 foot distance, MC. Clerk will amend the application to reflect this change.
9. **Discussion/possible action regarding establishment of standards and time frame to bring existing installation up to approved standards for parking areas constructed on Town Lands, such as those along Tipperary Rd. west of Whalen's Grade.** No formal action taken, Chairman will get input from a DNR representative for an informal meeting, the issue will be looked at as a case by case project and will need a set of guidelines for different types of scenarios.
10. **Discussion/possible action regarding request for speed limit reduction on Stebbins Rd. North of CTH CS.** Discussion only this is still a work in progress.
11. **Discussion/possible action on Ordinance 6.10 Tourist Rooming Houses, a licensing ordinance following the recommendations of the joint Town Board and Safety Committee meeting.** Teitgen/Schulenburg motion to limit rentals to 16 weeks per year, MF. Leckwee/Auck motion to have 1 quiet/no rentals week out of every month, MC. Leckwee/Smith motion to strike the last sentence from item #2 under definitions, MC, Smith/Auck motion to change Town Board to Town Constable under the Section of Inspection/Enforcement & Possible Revocation and to add complaint driven with reasonable cause, MC., site plan paragraph will also be stricken and a few other minor correction done prior to recommendation to the Town Board.
12. **Future agenda items. (No discussion permitted).** Stebbins Rd. speed limit reduction update, request for smart phones for the Constable and Town Chairman, request for forming Quick Response teams for storm issues.
