A Resolution in Support of
Measures to make the CTH CS/V Intersection Safer

WHEREAS, the intersection of County Highway CS and County Highway V threatens driver safety and contributes to countless accidents or near miss incidents each year, as drivers either miss the stop signs or stop within the portion of the intersection that does not have a stop sign; and

WHEREAS, this is an area that is traveled by many tourists and individuals that are unfamiliar with the area; and

WHEREAS, rumble strips have been proven to reduce crashes by up to 29%, however, the rumble strips on CTH CS have deteriorated to the point of not being useful; and

WHEREAS, visibility on CTH CS can be greatly reduced during early morning and late evening hours by sun glare; and

WHEREAS, LED lights have been proven to increase sign visibility and traffic compliance by up to 71%; and

WHEREAS, implementation of all way stops at intersections have been shown to increase safety by over 60%; and


WHEREAS: Having safe roads is vital to the success of municipalities; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the Town Board of the Town of Dekorra calls upon the Columbia County Board and Columbia County Highway Commission for the repair and of rumble strips on CTH CS and the installation of rumble strips on CTH V; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Town Board of the Town of Dekorra calls upon the Columbia County Board and Columbia County Highway Commission to implement a 3-way stop at the intersection of CTH CS and CTH V; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Town Board of the Town of Dekorra calls upon the Columbia County Board and Columbia County Highway Commission to install and use flashing LED stop signs at the intersection of CTH CS and CTH V;






